Garden Care

Plant loves good garden soil, full sun and regular watering. In the spring, sow in pots or directly in the garden. Barely cover, tamp securely and keep evenly moist, warm and in the light. Germination is in about a week. Thin or transplant to 6" to 12" apart. 40-50 days to maturity.

Herbal Actions

Actions Description	Actions Description Detail
Cholagogue	Stimulates the flow of bile from the liver (via the gallbladder). Sometimes synonymous with choleretic.
Vulnerary	Helps heal tissue both when applied topically or taken internally.
Antibacterial	Inhibits the growth and production of bacteria.
Antifungal	Inhibits the excess growth and production of fungal infections.
Anti-inflammatory	Alleviates inflammation.
Antioxident	Inhibits the production of free radicals in the body.
Antiviral	Inhibits growth and production of viruses.
Emmenagogue	Helps bring on menses.
Lymphagogue	Moves lymph fluids through the lymphatic system.
